Healthcare cost of stroke in Hungary = €276.5 million (€28 per capita)

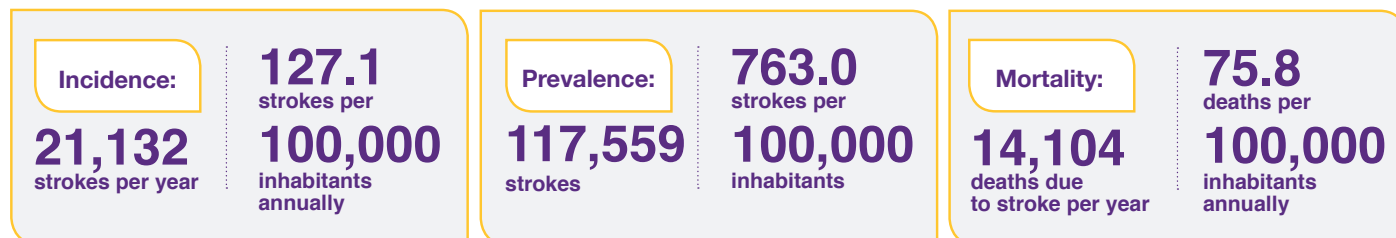
Treatment landscape:

Established National Stroke Strategy highlights stroke as a medical emergency and recommends public stroke awareness campaigns. A campaign was launched in 2009 by the Hungarian Stroke Society

A programme called "lysis alarm" was introduced at a tertiary medical centre involving pre-notification by the ambulance team prior to hospital arrival with a stroke patient

In 2010, The Ministry of National Resources issued guidelines for the treatment of stroke

Anticoagulant treatment rates:

No data has been published to demonstrate the use of oral anticoagulants in Hungary, however:

- According to data from the National Health Insurance Fund of Hungary thrombolysis rate was **3.2% nationally** in 2013, a doubling of the rate since 2008
- There were **37 active thrombolysis centres** performing **1,439 interventions**
