Project overview



- The SAFE Angels project was realised in the first half of 2018
- It involved translation to 13 European languages, design, printing and distribution of five different brochures for stroke patients and their carers
- The texts were kindly provided by Stroke Association UK
- 13 organisations from the following countries took part in this project and made sure these brochures were made available in the stroke units:

Spain, Serbia, Poland, Czech Republic, Latvia, Croatia, Macedonia, Greece, Ukraine, Georgia, Hungary and Turkey

By July 2018, all materials were placed in designated hospitals



Online Angels Survey

From end of July 2018 onwards, an online satisfaction survey was launched in 13 languages + English, assessing the quality and quantity of information patients are provided with during their stay in the hospital.
